

SUPPORT FOR BEHAVIOUR AND ENGAGEMENT: FACT SHEET

The vast majority of students are positively engaged in schooling and behave well. There are, however, a small proportion of students that require intensive engagement and behaviour support at some point in their schooling.

Key facts

- 13 Engagement Centres provide statewide support for the most challenging, complex and disengaged students. Every Education Region has an Engagement Centre (see below for locations).
- Whole school professional learning and support is available through the model. This includes CMS and PBS.
- A small, specialised school called the Midland Learning Academy has been established for some of our most extremely disengaged young people.
- A guarantee of service will apply for students that have been excluded and for any school-aged young person exiting a custodial sentence.
- These services are coordinated through the School of Special Educational Needs: Behaviour and Engagement (SSEN:BE).
